



Randall Shutt is the WITS Volunteer in charge of the electrical hookups on the floor. He is a good source of information before and during the show.

### **110 v**

Each booth is allocated one 20 amp, 110VAC receptacle located in the floor near the booth. The exhibitor must bring extension cords and plug-in strips to accommodate their needs. Although 25' of cord should be sufficient to reach your booth, placement of equipment within the booth may require additional lengths. The electrical plugs are mostly in the floor behind the booth – questions contact the Wits volunteer staff.

### **220v, 3-Phase 208v and 480v**

It is very important to contact the WITS office to request the electricity for your booth if it is above 110v. We have 220v single phase, 3-phase 480 and 208 available at the show but not everywhere in the Century II Expo Hall, is it very important to let the WITS office know of your of your booths requirements as early as possible before the show.

**Exhibitors are NOT allowed to make any electrical connections at Century II. All connections are made by site-authorized electricians and can be requested at the WITS office during set-up.**

**A licensed and authorized electrician at your expense must make the actual connections.** We will have electricians (same company as 2009) on site during setup and tear down to make the connections to the Century II electrical systems (floor, columns and overhead). Their charges are based on time and material. If you have any questions contact Randall Shutt at the WITS office.
